


Figure 2: Comparative analysis flow chart

Comparative analysis flow chart Figure.2:




Figure 3: Comparison of the number of reported

From the above Figure 3, we can clearly see that: The change of the 2010 South Africa World Cup coverage of The People's Daily and the New York Times with the time. The blue line represents that there are 224 new has been reported by the People's Daily in 47 days, the green line represents that there are 281 news has been reported by the New York Times in 47 days. The highest circulation of The People's Daily is 9 per day; the highest circulation of the New York Times is 14 per day. Among them, the circulation of New York Times is obviously higher than The People's Daily with the development of the 2010 World Cup in South Africa.

Then comparing the content between The People's Daily and the New York Times in the following aspects (Events, teams, players, fans, social life, referees, coaches, sports time, the application of science and technology in the World Cup, media coverage of the World Cup, the impression of South Africa, the influence of the World Cup in South Africa, Mr. Refusal, competition strategy and other sound). 


Figure 4: "People's Daily" reported content proportion

have reached 71%, Its concentration is relatively high, the rest 30% belonged to "others". The least one is "Mr. Refusal" which just had only one report.




Figure 5: "New York Times" reported content proportion




Figure 6 : Comparison of reported position histogram

In Figure 6: We get the Comparison of reported position histogram of The People's Daily and New York Times.
